**T**ith God, nothing is unexpected, While waiting to see the doctor, I met but for us, many things come into our lives unexpected. Past experience has taught us that when life surprises us, it means that God is at work.

We are thankful that we have running water again before my parents come to visit Moldova for the first time at the beginning of May.

Our Russian lessons continue to progress but with some unexpected benefits. While Romanian and Russian the are technical classification of Moldova's languages, many here speak "Moldovan." This amounts to Romanian with Russian words thrown in from time to time. While we are beginning to understand more Russian, we were surprised how much more "Moldovan" we are understanding. Though Russian is much more difficult than Romanian, we have no regrets in following the Lord's leading to learn Russian as well.
