As the season here in Moldova changes to summer, our schedule changes, too. Several ministries at the Ford's church pause during the summer months, and we will be able to focus more on studying Russian and making several important preparations for our second term. Thank you for praying for Andrei and I to get in touch once again. I had called his number for three weeks before I was able to get a hold of him. He had gone to Russia to seek work but returned unsuccessful. We were scheduled to get together, but he ended up finding work here and has since been unable to meet. Please pray for the Lord to work in his heart and for a time for us meet again.

At the beginning of May, my parents came to visit us for the first time and stayed ten days. They were able to experience firsthand how life is here in Moldova when you have to try to get something fixed. On the way to the airport to pick them up, our car started overheating. After adding antifreeze, spending another day changing the thermostat, and putting the car in the shop for 5 days to get the gasket head changed, we were able to get our car back and running the day before they had to go home. In spite of the unexpected issues with the car, we enjoyed showing them Moldova and the work here.

During their visit, I was able to meet a young man named Aliosha. I started talking with him, wanting to share the Gospel with him. As I soon found out, Russian is his first language. Between the little Russian I had learned and his little Romanian he knew, we were able to talk some, but not enough to talk

about Christ. Another missionary friend of mine (who has been studying Russian longer than we have) and I are working on our second attempt to meet with him. Please pray for us to clearly communicate the Gospel with Aliosha in his native tongue and for him to be saved.

In preparation for our first churchplant after furlough, we are working on gathering materials, Bibles being one of them. We have concluded that the Fidela (Faithful) Bible is the best translation available. It is a fairly new translation
